Dear Families,

We had a great week of school! On Tuesday, we had the opportunity to learn about firefighters and what they do, what they use, and how they stay safe. The students were so excited to meet some of the Foreston Firefighters. They even had the opportunity to sit inside a fire truck!

In Bible this week, we finished up our unit on Cain and Abel. We began our Inductive Bible Study. We read Joshua 1:8-9 and learned that the Bible is God's word and that we should read it, study it, think about it, and do what it says. We also got our new memory verse, which is 2nd Timothy 3:16.

In Kindergarten math, we have been learning more story problems and how to solve them. We also have been learning the ordinal positions from first to fourth.

For math in first grade, we have begun addition number sentences. The students have learned doubles; $1+1=2$, $2+2=4$, $3+3=6$, $4+4=8$, and $5+5=10$. They even learned a fun song to sing to remember it!

Spelling and reading has been a big part of this week. The students have been working hard at identifying phonograms in a word to sound out the words. They have been doing such a great job reading words. This weekend, please practice spelling and reading.
