Dear Families,

Here we are, one more week left of the school year. What a wonderful year it has been. Your child has grown *SO* much. It has been such an honor being your child's teacher this year! They are precious and wonderful.

In Bible this week, we learned about what our mission is as christians. In Matthew 28, Jesus gives the *Great Commission*. We are to go out and make disciples - we are to share the good news, the gospel! It is our mission to show people the love of Christ and to reach the lost. We talked about how Jesus will return and when he does, he will defeat Satan for good. Ask your child about our mission and how we are made more than victorious in Christ!

In Kindergarten math, the students were introduced to odd and even numbers. They practiced counting by 2s. They also measured with nonstandard feet. With a partner, they traced their feet on a piece of paper, cut them out, and then used those to measure how many 'feet' things are around the room.

For math in first grade, the students learned how to identify $\frac{1}{2}$, $\frac{1}{3}$, and $\frac{1}{6}$. They also learned the comparison symbols ($<$, $>$, $=$). They had fun pretending that the greater than and less than symbols were alligator mouths.
